ORDER

Government have introduced Special casual leave for a maximum of 45 days in a calendar year to those Employees who undergo kidney transplantation as per the order 1st read above and as per the guidelines issued in the order IInd read above.

The 90th meeting of the Executive Committee of IHRD which met on 19.03.2014 resolved to extend the benefit of the above said Government orders to IHRD Employees who undergo kidney transplantation.

The Heads of Institution concerned shall sanction Special casual leave upto 45 days in a calendar year to IHRD Employees who undergo kidney transplantation on production of a medical certificate from the authorised medical officer attending them under intimation to the Director IHRD and on strict compliance of all conditions laid down in the Government order.

ORDER

Government have introduced Special Casual Leave for a maximum of 45 days in a calendar year to those employees who undergo chemotherapy or radiation and kidney transplantation as per Government Order read above.

In furtherance thereof, Government are pleased to issue following guidelines for the leave sanctioning authorities:-

(i) Special Casual Leave for a period not exceeding 45 days in a calendar year may be granted to those employees who undergo chemotherapy or radiation and kidney transplantation on production of a medical certificate from the authorised medical officer to cover the actual period required for chemotherapy/radiation and kidney transplantation

followed by post-transplantation recovery.

- (ii) The leave may be allowed to be combined with leave defined in Rule 77 (i), Part I, KSRs and ordinary casual leave.
- (iii) The period of Special Casual Leave shall be exclusive of intervening public holidays.
- (iv) the leave may be availed of on more than one occasions in a calendar year, if needed, but altogether it must not exceed 45 days in a calendar year.

These orders shall have retrospective effect from 26/2/2011.

Necessary amendment to the Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
