Sub: IHRD - Launching of Haritha Kerala Mission – reg.

The Govt. of Kerala has informed that the Haritha Kerala Mission will be launched on the state on 8th December 2016. Hon'ble Chief Minister has stressed upon the Inter-departmental coordination for its successful implementation. Directions are being issued to all educational institutions to undertake substantial activities envisaged under Haritha Kerala Mission.

The following activities are currently proposed under Haritha Kerala mission.

1. A comprehensive project is being implemented to clear and remove waste from all the water bodies in Kerala; ponds, rivers, lakes and streams.
2. Disposal of solid waste, removal of waste water and measures to increase the area of land under cultivation will be undertaken under this project. Land cleaned up through this project will be used for vegetable cultivation, so as to achieve self sufficiency in agriculture. This will be a peoples' participatory program on the lines of literacy mission, democratic decentralization and peoples' planning.
3. Comprehensive waste management plan to collect, separate and recycle waste in panchayats and municipalities.
4. Power generation from solar energy and wind energy will also be a part of this project. A state level task force will supervise the implementation of this project.

In connection with the launching of Haritha Kerala mission on 8th December 2016, the following activities are suggested in all Institutions under IHRD.

- a) to undertake substantial activities envisaged under the Haritha Kerala Mission by all THSS, CAS, MPT and Engineering Colleges under IHRD.
- b) These activities will be treated as extra-curricular activities and will be undertaken on 8th December in lieu of classes. The 8th December will be a working day for all institutions and all staff and students shall participate in the activities scheduled on that day. The oath suggested by the suchitwa kerala mission shall be taken in all Institutions.
- c) The NSS units in the IHRD institutions shall undertake the activities under Haritha Kerala Mission as per the guidance of Principal.
- d) From 5th December 2016 to 8th December 2016, messages pertaining to Suchitwa Mission and Haritha Keralam should be read out during assemblies of all Technical Higher Secondary schools.

The head of IHRD Institutions shall ensure that these activities suggested by the Haritha Kerala Mission will be conducted at their Institution and a compliance report shall be furnished on 09-12-2016.
