
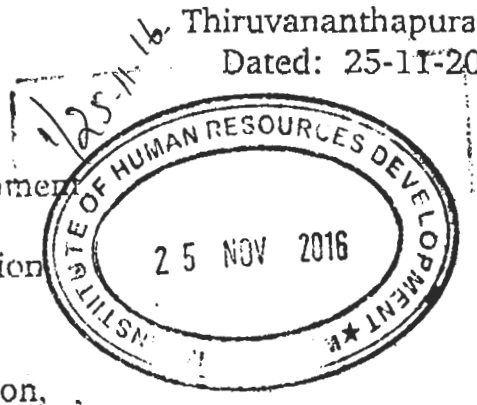

Vijay,

I write in the context of the Government of India's decision to celebrate 26th November, each year as 'Constitution Day'.

2. As part of the celebrations this year, an indicative and suggested list of activities that could be taken up by educational institutions including schools and colleges is as follows:

- i) Reading of the Preamble to the Constitution.
- ii) Reading of the fundamental duties as enshrined in Article 51A of the Constitution.
- iii) Activities such as debates, speeches, essays and quiz competitions on the Constitution of India.

This is an indicative list, and especially for the education sector. It could be built upon by the States, and enlarged to cover other activities as well, keeping the objectives of the observance in mind.

3. This year Constitution Day would fall on a Saturday. The activities indicated above could be carried out in schools and colleges on the 25th November, in case 26th November is observed as a holiday.

4. I would request you to have suitable instructions issued to all concerned for observance of the Constitution Day in the educational institutions in your State/UT.

5. I would also request you to subsequently send to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, reports, photographs and multimedia documentation of the observance. This would also enable us to project the activities carried out by your State.
