## **CIRCULAR**

The following instructions are issued consequent to the Video Conference conducted by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 on flood relief measures. All departmental heads in the districts are directed to act in accordance with the decisions taken, and further instructions issued by the District Collectors with respect to flood relief operations.

- Drinking water to be supplied at all camps; quality of drinking water is to be maintained at the appropriate/prescribed level. Kerala Water Authority to take necessary steps in this regard. Wherever services of Kerala Water Authority are not available, District Collectors may make alternate arrangements.
- 2) Availability of rice, vegetables and other common cereals with enough protein content to be supplied to all camps as per their requirements. As far as possible these items should be supplied by the local Maveli stores and Supplyco outlets.
- 3) There have been requests from people who own cattle but unable to feed them. Arrangements to be made by Animal Husbandry Dept to supply necessary cattle feed wherever required.
- 4) Health Department should ensure prevention of contagious diseases. As water level recedes the chances of such diseases breaking out are more. Specific attention needs to be focused in making available, sufficient numbers of medical personnel and medicines.
- 5) Local Self Government Institutions should take up the lead in initiating clean-up operations once the water level goes down. These activities need to be carried out in collaboration with local NGOs and other service organisations.
- 6) There is a provision for providing Rs.3800 for the houses submerged, as per G.O (Ms).No194/2015/DMD dated 20th May, 2015. This money is to be distributed completely in the next 24 hours.
- 7) Children who lost their text books due to flood should be supplied with replacement books urgently.
- 8) Supply of clean toilets in camps and areas wherever required should be undertaken immediately to prevent health hazards.

- 9) Shortage of cooking gas has been indicated in a few places. Food & Civil Supplies Department should initiate interaction with IOC/BPCL, to ensure availability of cooking gas.
- 10) Old-age pension certificates that are to be distributed may not be delayed.
- 11) As water recedes there is a chance of submerged houses collapsing, if they are not properly built. There should be focus on preventing such mishaps and consequent injury to people.
- 12) There may be cases where people require food, but are unable to visit camps or gruel centres. Such cases, if any, need to be attended to and food reached to such people.
- 13) The District Collectors should nominate an officer of appropriate level and rank to act as Nodal Officer for each camp; it shall be the duty of the Nodal Officer to attend to all matters related to the camp and take action to see that evacuees receive full attention and consideration of the District Administration.
- 14) Public Works Department will take immediate steps to carry out repair works to the roads fully damaged by flood so as to make them motorable.

All officers are requested to implement the above decisions scrupulously.
