ORDER

In the Government order read above, Sanction was accorded by Government to extend the benefits of Special Casual Leave for 30 days to Government employees who undergo Angioplasty. Several requests have been received from IHRD employees to extend the benefits. The matter was placed before the Executive Committee. The 104th meeting of the Executive Committee of IHRD held on 30.11.2021 resolved to extend the benefits of the above Government order to IHRD employees also on the same terms and condition. In the above circumstances, the following orders are issued.

1. Sanction is accorded to extend the benefits of Special Casual Leave for 30 days who undergo Angioplasty as applicable to State Government employees to IHRD employees also on the same terms and conditions of the Government order.
2. The head of institutions concerned shall sanction Special Casual Leave upto 30 days on production of medical certificate from an authorized

Medical Officer in strict compliance of all conditions laid down in the Government order under intimation to IHRD (Headquarters).

ORDER

The Government employees who undergo heart surgery are eligible for Special Casual leave under Rule 19, Section II, Appendix VII, Part I, the Kerala Service Rules, for a period not exceeding 45 days in a calendar year on production of certificate to that effect from an authorised Medical Officer.

2. Now a doubt has been raised as to whether the benefit can be extended to those who undergo Angioplasty also.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the Government employees who undergo angioplasty will be granted Special Casual Leave upto 30 days subject to the same conditions as under Rule 19, Section II, Appendix VII, Part I, the Kerala Service Rules.

4. However, past cases settled otherwise, if any, will not be re-opened.

5. Necessary amendments to the Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
