Sub:—Public Service—Extension of joining time—Candidates undergoing Ph. D. programme—Clarification—Issued—Reg.

2. Circular No. 5966/Adv. C3/2000/P&ARD dated 28-6-2000.

Instructions were issued as per the Government Order and Circular cited to regulate the procedure regarding grant of extension of joining time to candidates advised for appointment in Government Service by Kerala Public Service Commission and reporting of Not Joining Duty vacancies to the Public Service Commission.

As per the Circular cited 2nd above, joining time beyond 45 days can be granted by Government to those candidates who are in the midst of any educational course or are undergoing any training so as to enable them to complete the course/training and then to report for duty.

It has come to the notice of Government that candidates undergoing Ph. D. programme are requesting for extension of joining time to complete the same.

In the event of not sanctioning extension of joining time, the candidate may have to abandon the Ph. D. programme. In the larger interest of our country, research works require to be promoted. Government have examined the matter in detail in consultation with Kerala Public Service Commission. Government Order that extension of joining time will not be granted for undergoing Ph. D. programme in future. However the candidates engaged in research programme have the liberty to join duty and thereafter avail themselves of Leave Without Allowances under Appendix XII B Part I KSR for the successful completion of their research work.
